Entry Conditions

Entry Fee: There is an entry fee of £20.00 for England Netball affiliated teams and £35.00 for non-affiliated teams, which is a contribution towards the running costs of the event. All cheques should be made payable to England Netball.

Mixed Team Participation: Mixed teams can be submitted and will play in a separate league if numbers allow. Below are some rules surrounding mixed teams participation in the competition.

- There can be a maximum of three males on court at one time.
- The male players can only play in one of the following positions at any one time:
 - 1) Either Goal Shooter or Goal Attack.
 - 2) Either Centre or Wing Attack or Wing Defence.
 - 3) Either Goal Defence or Goal Keeper

Eligibility: Athletes must have an IQ below 75, limited adaptive behaviour (i.e. needs support to achieve everyday tasks) and the disability must have occurred before the age of 18 (all these criteria must be met).

Team Rating: A team rating will need to be completed as part of team registration form which will be distributed after the entries closing date. Each player will need to be rated using the below categories. These ratings may be used to group teams with similar abilities.

- Category 1: Player has experience of playing the game for a while or had a good level of understanding of the game/skills. Players' ability level is at a proficient standard.
- Category 2: Player had not played the game for a while but has an average level of understanding of the game/skills. Players' ability level is at a reasonable standard.
- Category 3: Player has not got a good understanding of the game/skills. Players' ability level is at a limited standard.

Entry Deadline: The Competition and Events department must receive your completed Entry Form, together with your payment, no later than **Friday 13th May 2016**. We cannot guarantee any entries received after this date will be accommodated.
